

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OLIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD April 7 ,2015 at 7:00 PM

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Alfredo Santos that the March 3, 2015 minutes be approved as read, motion carried.

Treasurer's report was given, approximately \$453,170.00 on hand in the general fund.

Fire Chief reported on 2 assists; 1 in Pigeon and 1 at Oak Beach, also 1 chimney fire South of Elkton. Bills were presented for the month. It was moved by Alfredo Santos, supported by Tom Ziel that we approve 2 new firemen for the Department who are Jacob Evans and William Rathje, motion carried.

No site permits were issued for the month.

Supervisor reported on website cost of \$899.00 + \$199.00per year, first year free, he is looking into getting more bids.
