

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OLIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD Feb 3, 2015 at 7:00 PM

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Alfredo Santos the minutes of the January 6, 2015 meeting be approved as read, motion carried.

Treasurers' report was given, approximately \$89,343.00 in the General Fund.

Fire Chief reported on 3 fire runs for the month: 1 false alarm, 1 tanker assist, 1 rollover accident, also presented bills. Chief reported that Jeff Mallory will be no longer a fireman on the department. Chief reported that there will be no fireman's Dinner party this winter

No site permits were issued.

A committee from the Elkton Village Council approached the Board wanting a contribution to help defray the cost of rebuilding North Elkton Rd from Railroad tracks north to edge of village limits. The Council presented a 5 years plan for the Village.

Supervisor gave a tentative road plan for 2015 that is attached to the back of these minutes.

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Alfredo Santos that we follow the State guidelines on the establishment on the poverty guidelines for the 2015 Board of Review, the Board approved less their homes, establishing a cap of liquid assets not to exceed \$25,000.00 to go by, motion carried.

Budget hearing is set for March 17, 2015 at 7:00 pm.

Supervisor reported that our County Commissioner will not be attending this meeting. Commissioner told the Supervisor that he is not in favor of the moratorium.

Assessors report: On Feb 11, 2015 the Board of Review will have a training seminar at Bad Axe.

Supervisor is looking into a new web site for the Township.

Brining bids: It was moved by Alfredo Santos, supported by Tom Ziel that we approve Wilkinson Corp. bid on brining the Township roads. The road Commission is going to try a new material on ¼ of Grassmere Rd. 50-50 with the Road Commission.

It was moved by Robert Krohn, supported by Tom Ziel that all salaries and fees remain the same for the fiscal year of 2015, motion carried.

Supervisor reported on joint Road Commission meeting being held April 9, 2015 at the KC hall in Bad Axe, all Board members are urged to attend.

All Board members that attended the MTA Convention gave a brief and outstanding report on the different classes that they attended.
