

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OLIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD September 8, 2015 at 7:00 P.M.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

Treasurers' report was given, approximately \$479,208.00 on hand in the General Fund.

Fire chief reported on fire runs; fallen tree, 1 P.I. accident on Richardson Rd, a deck fire, and another P.I. accident, also presented bills. Chief reported that they had a good turnout for the Autumn fest chicken bar-b-que the fire department put on. It was moved by Alfredo Santos, supported by Jeanette Renn that we appoint two new firemen to the department, they are John H. Gunden and Shawn E. Thayer motion carried.

Michael Sage, representing DTE , gave a brief report on what is happening with the new wind project in the Township.

Dave Ondrajenko, CPA from Anderson and Tuckey gave a brief report on the bi-annual audit recently done for the Township. All fund balances are in good standing, and he commended the Board on the excellent booking.

Dick Krohn and Margo Barry approached the Board on problems with wind farms across the Country. They are stating we have enough windmills in Oliver Township. If they do not want windmills they should take it up with DTE.

Supervisor reported that Moore Rd south of Stein Rd is finished, new blacktopping on Maxwell Rd is done and Stein Rd blacktopping will be started in a week or so.

Supervisor also reported that North Main St in Elkton road project will be put off until 2016.

Tony Ruthowski, assessor was not at meeting, no report.

Discussion on the Pigeon District Library millage, Supervisor will obtain the papers to have the millage reduced.
