

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OLIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD May 3, 2016 at 7:00 PM

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

Members present Larry Krohn, Robert Krohn, Jeanette Renn, Alfredo Santos, Tom Ziel.

It was moved by Alfredo Santos, supported by Jeanette Renn that the minutes of the April 5, 2016 meeting be approved as read, motion carried.

Treasurers' report was given, approximately \$435,700.45 on hand in the general fund.

Fire Chief reported on 1 false fire alarm for the month, also presented bills. It was moved by Alfredo Santos, supported by Tom Ziel that the Township purchase new facial helmet straps for the department, motion carried. Chief reported on the upcoming breakfast that will be held on May 15, 2016 at the fire hall.

No site permits for the month.

A group from Exelon, Vista, and Michigan Wind explained to the Board what caused the collapse of a wind turbine. Sean Melander representing Vista, presented a drawing of a hydraulic cylinder controlling the blades, stating that the cylinders are showing some wear therefore losing pressure at the cylinder end seals causing blades to run out of control. All cylinders are being checked for wear and replaced if necessary.

Margo Barry will be meeting with Exelon for the proper papers that she will fill out for her complaint on the turbines.

Supervisor reported on finalizing the work orders for the road commission. Decision on whether to move or not to move ditch on Stein Rd. after discussion it was decided to have the ditch moved.

Brion Dickens, representing the planning commission, reported they are moving along with the final updates of the zoning ordinance, he said it will not be done by the July quarterly meeting.

Assessor, Tony Rutkowski said everything is running smoothly.

Commissioner, Swartzendruber reported on mosquito control in the county, and how the county would pay for it.

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Jeanette Renn that we appoint two members for a 3 year term on the planning commission which are Brion Dickens and Al Bumhoffer, motion carried.
