

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OLIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD October 4, 2016 at 7:00 PM

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

Members present Larry Krohn, Robert Krohn Tom Ziel Alfredo Santos, and Jeanette Renn.

It was moved by Tom Ziel supported by Alfredo Santo that the minutes of the Sept 6, 2016 consent agenda (minutes) be approved , motion carried.

Treasurers' report was given, approximately \$89,943.00 on hand in the general fund.

Fire chief reported on 2 assists with other townships, 1 ambulance assist, 1 electrical pole fire in Elkton, 1 windmill roll over truck, and 1 accident assist at Moore and Richardson Rd, also presented bills. It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Alfredo Santos that we appoint Tim Russell back on the fire department, motion carried. Township Board sent out a questionnaire to the fireman, 8 of the 20 responded. All questions were answered. The questionnaire attached to back of minutes.

No update on ITC transmission line or Exelon #6 wind turbine. DTE responded with a text message, the first week of December will be startup for the Pinnebog Wind farm.

Supervisor reported the road work is completed except for Born Rd.

Brion Dickens reported on the township survey results. Out of 290 surveys were mailed out, 94 were returned, 71% are in favor of wind energy. 29 % apposed. This survey attached to back of minutes. Brion also reported that there will be a regular planning commission meeting 10/20/16.

Rich Swartzendruber, commissioner, reported on a favorable decision on the way the wind turbines will be taxed, hopefully DTE and Next Era will follow them, also reported that there will be a special County Planning commission meeting 10/5/16.

Tony Rutkowski, assessor also reported on the new wind turbine tax schedule.

Supervisor reported the wind survey will be sent out to the Village residence with their water bill.

Supervisor and trustee attended the fall MTA meeting in Frankenmuth, they reported it was a good meeting.
