

Regular Meeting of the Oliver Township Board June 6, 2017 at 7:00 P.M.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

Members present: Larry Krohn, Robert Krohn, Jeanette Renn, Kevin McKenzie , & Tom Ziel .

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Kevin McKenzie that we approve the agenda, motion carried.

It was moved by Robert Krohn, supported by Tom Ziel that May 2, 2017 consent agenda (minutes) be approved, motion carried.

Treasures' report was given, approximately \$510,907.00 on hand in the general fund.

Fire Chief reported on 2 fire runs for the month, 1 PII accident and 1 house fire. Chief reported that there was a good turnout at the pancake breakfast. It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Jeanette Renn that the fire department look into writing a grant for new equipment for the department up to \$4900.00 matching monies, motion carried. On May 26, 2017 the fire department held an open house for school kids to tour the equipment at the hall. After discussion, it was moved by Kevin McKenzie, supported by Robert Krohn that we approve the applications of two new firemen: Jared Schuette and Hunter Seley, motion carried.

No site permits were issued.

It was moved by Kevin MCKENZIE, SUPPORTED BY ROBERT Krohn that we try to move our old rescue truck at the auction, once more no reserve will be set at this time, motion carried.

Jason Lemont gave a presentation to the Township Board on a proposal to consult with the fire department for a period of eight months service for the fee of \$16,000.00.

No reports of wind or ITC projects at this time.

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Kevin McKenzie that we approve the planning commissions recommended changes, to our zoning ordinance, which are attached to these minutes, motion carried.

Public Comments: Margo Barry, Nancy and Dick Krohn, all commented that our zoning changes are not strong enough for them.

Brion Dickens, chairman of planning commission, reported on his attendance May 21, 2017 at Frankenmuth on planning issues.

Next planning commission will be held on July 20, 2017 at 7:00 pm.

Steve Vaughn, commission for our district, reported on the moratorium on solar for 1 year at the county level and the many contracts that are coming up for negotiations with county employees.

Tony Rutkowski, assessor, reported that there will be a Board of Review meeting in July. Tony is going to attend the GIS class at the cost of \$100.00 on June 14, 2107 at the Huron County Expo Center. It was moved by Jeanette Renn supported by Robert Krohn that we approve this class for Tony, motion carried. It was moved by Robert Krohn, supported by Jeanette Renn that we pay the equalization department \$112.50 for the subscription to FetchGis for 6 months, motion carried.

Vault cleanup project is still ongoing.

Road Commission update was given by Supervisor, Larry Krohn.
