

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OLIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD Sept 5, 2017 at 7:00 PM

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

It was moved by Jeanette Renn , supported by Tom Ziel that the August 1, 2017 consent agenda (minutes) be approved motion carried.

Treasurer's report was given, approximately \$500,715.38 on hand in the general fund.

Fire Chief reported 1 house fire, 1 downed wire, 1 car accident assist, 1 barn fire for the month, also presented bills. Chief reported that they had an excellent turnout for the Autumnfest chicken barbecue. They sold 380 chicken halves after the parade. Chief reported the leak on the tanker will be repaired but will take a couple weeks before the company can do so. Overhead door has been fixed in the fire hall, also no new news on the grant being written. Jason Lamont presented his bill and a brief reported on what they are working on in our fire department.

Site permits: Herford brothers, a straw and storage shed, value \$230,000.00.

Clerk reported no audit will be discussed at this months' meeting, hopefully next month.

Supervisor and Tony Rutkowski will be meeting with Dave McArthur for a possible candidate for our assessing work.

The medical marijuana issue will be discussed at the next regular meeting.

Update on 2017 road projects: at this time Moore Rd between Stein and Kilmanagh blacktopping has not been done, Farver Rd between 142 to Geiger 1 lift, Haist Rd from Hartsell to Moore Rd 1 lift, Stein Rd stone on south shoulder, done, Installation of tubes partly done. Brining will be going on next week, and road side mowing will be completed by the end of this month.

Planning commission reported nothing new has been brought up. Steve Vaughn, commissioner reported that Colfax township is in the process of writing a medical marijuana resolution. Also reported that various subjects at the County level. No assessor report was given..Clerk reported we have all new voting machines for upcoming elections, paid for by state election commission. Ken Lund representing our insurance Co. for Oliver Township gave a brief report on the different coverage the township has. Total insurance package will be up approximately \$200.00 from previous year.
