

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OLIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD Nov 7, 2017 at 7:00 pm

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

Present at the meeting: Larry Krohn, Robert Krohn, Jeanette Renn, Tom Ziel and Kevin Mckenzie.

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Jeanette Renn that we approve the agenda, motion carried.

It was moved by Jeanette Renn, supported by Robert Krohn that the October 3, 2017 consent agenda, (minutes) be approved, motion carried.

Correction of the October 2017 minutes, correction is we did not formally opt out to authorize any type of medical marijuana facility in the Township .

Treasurers' report was given approximately \$165,935.00 on hand in the general fund.

Fire chief reported on 1 P.I. accident, 1 assist, 1 power line down, 1 false alarm at Lakers, 2 smoke alarms in the Village of Elkton, also 1 farm accident on Geiger Rd. Chief reported that the leak on the tanker has been fixed. After discussion it was moved by Tom Ziel supported by Jeanette Renn that in addition to the firemans pay we compensate the fire chief, the ass't fire chief, and the secretary/ treasurer of the fire department an additional \$500.00 per person for the extra work they have done during 2016-2017 year for the department, motion carried. Jason Lemont presented his bill for the month to the township Board. It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Robert Krohn that we donate \$300.00 to the Friends of Elkton Club, motion carried. Jim Seley presented the firemans pay for the fiscal year of 2016-2017, 51 possible runs, 11 of those runs were lift/assist ambulance runs at an average of 9 people per assist.

Site permits: #366-17 Ron Nimitz –shed valued at \$16,000.00. #367-17 Robert Krohn-\$59,000.00 shed.

Clerk reported that the state has rejected the petitions, andl they come back to our lawyer to make a decision if it is ok or not, the petition will be held at the August Primary in 2018.

Treasurer reported on the refund issue, with the state ,on Exelon IFT.

Supervisor presented some figures on next years' village projections for street building, tabled till later date.

Supervisor read a letter from the Huron County Road Commission . After discussion it was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Kevin McKenzie that the Board is not in favor of house bills # 5096,5097, 5098. Resolution attached to back of these minutes.

Thumb Electric zoning request addition, was turned over to the planning commission.

Steve Vaughn, commissioner gave a report at the county level, particularly with the Huron /county Planning /commission, stating that the corporate council has to be at the meeting to moderate these meetings.
