Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

It was moved by Tom Ziel supported by Kevin McKenzie that we approve the agenda, motion carried.

It was moved by Jeannette Renn supported by Tom Ziel that the February 6, 2018 consent agenda (minutes) be approved, motion carried..

Treasurers' report was given, approximately \$528,769.00 on hand in the general fund. Approximately 97% of the taxes are paid.

Fire chief reported that they had toured the Tower plant in February, also reported on runs :2/9/18 smoke detector going off no fire present. Consumer went out to check for gas.2/13/18 Tanker assist to Bad Axe, 2-16-18 tanker assist to Winsor, later called off.3/2/18 P.I. accident at the corner of Fillion and Maxwell,3/3/18 pickup fire on Campbell road. Chief reported that the jaws of life has been serviced, also Chief reported Jeff Dexter retired from the fire department. Chief reported the rescue truck is losing antifreeze, have taken the truck to Osentoski's for oil samples and will monitor and wait 50 hours to sample again. There is a one year warranty on the truck. Chief reported that all trucks were washed and waxed by two people that needed to do public service. The Board was showed the new flashlights that were purchased. Chief reported that West Shore will be giving us a quote on turnout gear for the department, also presented various bills for the month.

No site permits were issued for the month.

Referendum is on the May election ballot.

Dave McArthur passed his level 3 assessing class. Larry & Tony met with Dave. Larry reviewed his resume with the Board. Tony will be working thru the end of June.

It was moved by Tom Ziel, supported by Jeannette Renn that we contribute \$30,000.00 to the Maude St Village project, motion carried.

Supervisor reported that there will be a meeting with the Road Commission March 6, 2018 at 9:00 am, all Board members are urged to attend.

Supervisor reported that he has talked with Larry Merrill letting us know that we are classified as a distressed area and thus eligible for favorable grant status.

Assessor report not available, but the board of review will meet next Monday and Tuesday the March 12 & 13.

The Board set March 27 for the upcoming budget meeting.
