Township Board discussed what blacktopping will be done in next fiscal year, after discussion it was moved by Robert Krohn, supported by Tom Ziel that ,will have new asphalt on Stein Rd between Grassmere and Moore, and each side of be 1 foot wider along the mile. 1 mile Krohn Road from M142 to Richardson Rd and Richardson from Gagetown Rd to Maxwell Rd, motion carried.

Building repairs will be put off until 2019, No contractors are available they are too busy.
