

## Minutes of March 5 2019, regular Oliver Township Board meeting

Supervisor Larry Krohn opened the meeting at 7:00 pm with the pledge of allegiance

Members present were Supervisor Larry Krohn, Treasurer Jeanette Renn and trustees Tom Ziel and Kevin McKenzie. Absent was Robert Krohn, clerk. Jeanette Renn, treasurer, recorded the minutes.

It was moved by Tom Ziel and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kevin McKenzie to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jeanette Renn and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom Ziel to approve the consent agenda (minutes). Motion carried.

Treasurer's report showed a balance on hand of \$489,205.12. \$125,958.14 in delinquent taxes is owed the township.

Fire Chief Jim Seley's report: 2/17/19 PI accident on Sebewaing Road, 2/24/19 downed wire on trees on Hartsell & Geiger Road intersection. Tanker truck seal leak repaired. Chief to get estimate on pump rebuild and valve leak on pumper. Pickup speedometer is being repaired.

No site permits.

**Old business:** Hall eave troughs scheduled to be replaced sometime later this month.

**New business:** The village of Elkton would like to discuss sharing the cost of police protection. Tom Ziel and Kevin McKenzie will meet with the village police committee to discuss the proposal on March 7.

Ken Lind, our insurance agent, stated that due to the growth in attendance at the chicken barbecue, a rider may have to be added to our policy.

More information will be gathered on what material to use on the front fascia of the hall. A decision will be made at the April meeting.

The annual meeting with the Road Commission will be on April 11, 2019, at 9:00 am.

A motion by Tom Ziel, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kevin McKenzie to hold the April meeting on April 9 was approved. Supervisor is unable to attend the April 2 meeting.

Supervisor received a request to see if the township could use the county's noise meter to check on turbine noise. Supervisor will gather information on this.

On February 27, Tom Ziel and Larry Krohn attended MTA's legislative conference in Lansing. They met with Rep Phil Green and attended classes on various topics related to township government.

There was no assessors report or planning commission report.

Commissioner Steve Vaughn reported on various happenings at the county level.

The budget hearing will be held on March 26, 2019, at 7 pm at the township hall.

Motion by Tom Ziel and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jeanette Renn to pay the bills including Rd Comm. Motion carried.
