Pledge of allegiance was recited.

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Larry Krohn.

Treasurer's report was given, approximately \$446,500.00 on in the general fund.

Fire Chief reported, this Saturday there will be an open house from 9:00am to 12:00 noon, at the fire hall. Sebewaing Rd and Elkton road, a grass fire, turbine fire, 1 assist, 1 P>I> accident, 1 assist, Craig Gettel grass fire.

Old business : Trustees reported meeting with the Village on police protection, nothing was decided.

New business: Supervisor reported on the survey on running on a non-partisan ballot, it was moved by Jeanette Renn, supported by Robert Krohn that the Board is in opposition to legislation that would allow township boards the option to have its elected offices appear as nonpartisan on the ballot, roll call vote: Supervisor –yes, Clerk-yes, treasurer- yes, Trustee – yes, trustee- yes, motion carried.

Sheriff Kelly Hanson reported on how the Sheriff department is handling things at County level and in our Township, no big changes reported.

The fascia of front of the Firehall will be picked out shortly.
