- Approval of agenda. Moved by Tom Ziel, seconded by Jeanette Renn. Motion passed.

- Consent agenda adoption. Minutes of July2, 2019 board meeting. Moved to accept, Bob Krohn and seconded by Kevin McKenzie. Motion passed.

- Fire Chief's report.
 - Township hall looks good.
 - Bill for storage of antique fire truck was \$300 for 1 year.
 - Turn out gear is coming for September.
 - Tanker checks, tankers need testing. Tested hoses two weeks ago should get some new ones.
 - Fire runs:
 - July 9 Self propelled chopper fire.
 - July 20 tanker assist.
 - July 27 lift assist.
 - July 28 lift assist
 - July 30 van hit electric power pole in Elkton.
 - Fire department department will work on air pack replacements.

 - On the 10th and 11th our contractor is coming to paint township hall. Discussion about how it should be power washed first, primed and then painted.
