Treasurer's report. Current balance is \$333,310.14

Fire Chief's report:  
The fire department had jaws of life training.

One new fireman trainee had to move outside of the district for work, so three of the new trainees remain.

The Elkton golf course had a bocce ball tournament. The department took their lighting equipment out to light the area in the evening. It was a good test for the equipment.  
Fire Chief Jim Seley reported that the pagers were \$425 each. A little lower price than expected.

The fire department will not be open for Halloween activities because of Covid concerns.

The fire department will be participating in fire prevention week at the Laker elementary school.

A brief discussion was held about the N.F.R.I.S. (A national computer system to track fire department runs). It was determined that Oliver township was not included in this year's data. Dan Armbruster will work on this problem.

Assessor's report:  
Dave McArther reported they may have a December 8th Board Of Review. Because Dave assesses more than one Township he talked about splitting the board of review and having one day at Grant Township. No decision was made and it was tabled until November.

Planning commission report:  
Bob Ross reported the planning commission had not met since the last township meeting but would discuss solar ordinances during its October meeting.

Bob krohn requested to split 2 acres out from a farm on Eby road approximately 1/4 mile west of Hartsell Road. This parcel would be removed from PA 116 and used for his grandson's new homesite. Motion by Tom Ziel to remove said property from PA 116, seconded by Bob Ross. Motion passed by unanimous rollcall vote.

A brief discussion was held about a Covid grant, standby fees for Grant and Chandler townships and a future solar ordinance.
